



SELECTION OF STUDENTS COUNCIL 2018-2019

Students interested in taking up a responsible position in the school during the academic session 2018-2019 are required to apply for the same. The application should be accompanied with a detailed resume in the format provided.

A student will be assessed on the following parameters for being chosen for any position in Students' Council.

1. Academic record of Classes IX, X and XI.
2. Sense of discipline: Consistent high standard of behavior within and outside school
3. Attendance and regularity: Minimum 85% attendance is compulsory
4. Diligence in classroom learning
5. Turnout
6. Attitude towards classmates/ teachers/ school
7. Leadership skills: Ability to lead peers/ team spirit
8. Tries to be an example and model to fellow students
9. Confidence in public situations
10. Participation in : House activities, school events, intra school / inter school competitions, etc
11. Thoughts/ contribution towards overall development of the school
12. Teachers feedback
13. Should be willing to put in extra effort and time for execution of duties.
14. Have support, full acknowledgement , undertaking and consent from parents/ guardians

The shortlisted candidates will undergo a personal interview with the Selection Board and the decision of the selection board in the allotment of various responsibilities will be final.

Last date for submitting the completed applications: Monday 15 January 2018.

PROCESS FOR THE SELECTION OF STUDENTS COUNCIL 2018-2019

Stage One

Completion of Student Leader Application Form (attached) with candidates addressing the four questions that are listed. Each answer should not exceed more than 150 words.

Stage Two

Students will prepare and deliver a speech (not exceeding 02 minutes) on why they wish to be considered for a position of student leadership and how they would contribute to the well being of our learning community. From the speech delivered, students will be short listed. Short listed students will proceed to stage 3.

Stage Three

Candidates who are short listed will face an interview with the Selection Panel. They will be given advance notice of the interview.

Stage Four

Selection panel will assess the candidates as per their performance in the following:

1. Written Application
2. Speech
3. Interview
4. Teachers feedback

Stage Five

The Selection panel will then consider, evaluate and appoint the most suitable candidate for each of the positions. In the event a student does not accept the position then the Selection panel will offer the position to the next most suitable candidate .

Stage Six

Members of Students Council will be sworn in during the School Investiture ceremony.

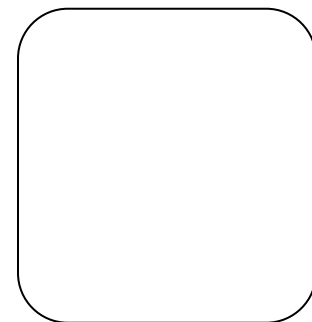

DE-POST CRITERIA
OF
STUDENTS COUNCIL

1. If the student's academic performance falls below the school criteria.
