A workshop on social skills and etiquette was conducted by the educators of Sr. KG to Class II.
















### **PROUD REFLECTIONS 2018-19**



The Shishukunj International School produced **BEST RESULT IN THE CITY** of classes X and XII with **HIGHEST** school averages of 88.07% and 86.80%(after re-evaluation) respectively. 'School Average' is the average of individual percentages of all the students and **NOT THE TOPPERS ALONE**.

'ASSET' is a nationally acclaimed test for academic audit. ASSET report speaks of the academic health of a school. ASSET is taken by approximately 1000 reputed schools of India and over 3,50,000 students appear in the test every year.

We are happy to share that more than 50% students from Classes III to X of The Shishukunj International School, Indore, fall in the category of top-16 percentile at National level:

- i. 80 students among top 1% nationally,
- ii. 340 students among next top 5% nationally and
- iii. 585 students among next 10% nationally.

Shishukunj students have performed:

- i. 16% to 44% higher than the National benchmark
- ii. 13% to 33% higher than the regional benchmark and
- iii. 18% to 46% higher than Metro benchmark (nearest metro Mumbai).

In Mathematics and Science, all classes (except Mathematics of grade 3) are above average when bench-marked with top 10 ASSET schools of India.

This year again, for the seventh consecutive year, we have been adjudged 'The Best Co-ed Day School' of Madhya Pradesh by the Education World Cfore Survey.

The Shishukunj International School, Indore, has been recognized as one of 'The Economic Times Best Education Brands 2019' in a research involving over 9000 participants across the country.
