- ❑ The young Shishyans participated in the Sahodya Inter School Swimming Championship 2015 held at New Digamber Public School, Indore. The Shishyans who have brought laurels to the school are -
  - Ayushman Singh of class III (E) secured 2nd position (Silver) in 50m Butterfly Stroke and 1st position (Gold) in 4 × 50 m Freestyle Relay.
  - Arjav Choklia of Class V (B) secured 1st position (Gold) in 4 × 50 m Freestyle Relay.
  - Aagam Chawla of Class V (A) secured 3rd position (Bronze) in 100m Breaststroke and 1st position (Gold) in 4 × 50 m Freestyle Relay.
  - Rahil Kishnani of Class V (D) secured 1st position (Gold) in 4 × 50 m Freestyle Relay.
- ❑ Our school hosted the Basantilal ji Sethia Inter School swimming Competition. Our school bagged the overall championship by scoring 244 points and defeated The Daly College Indore which secured second position with 163 points and The Emerald Heights International School which secured third position with 126 points.

- ❑ Alana Patidar , Diya Jain and Anvisha Bourasi represented the school in the CBSE WEST ZONE SWIMMING COMPETITION-2015 held at Ajmer (Rajasthan) from 3rd to the 6th of October. They won the bronze medal in the U-12 , 4X50 Metres Relay.
