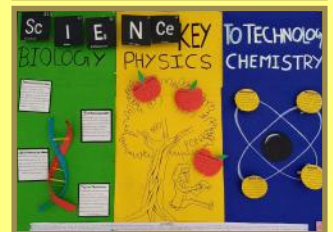

## Documentary Making Competition

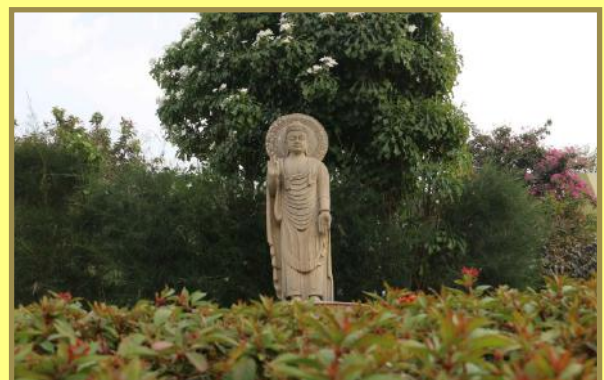
In this competition, each House was required to make a film on the school and how Shishukunj is a different School of thought.
