

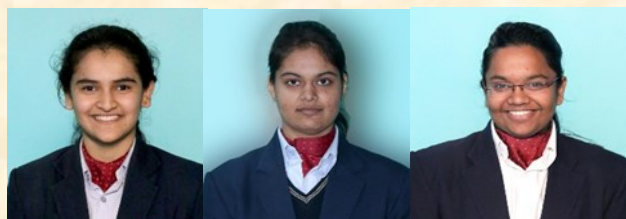

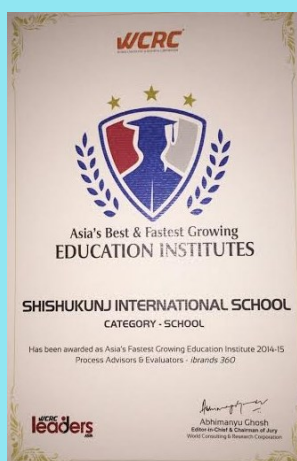

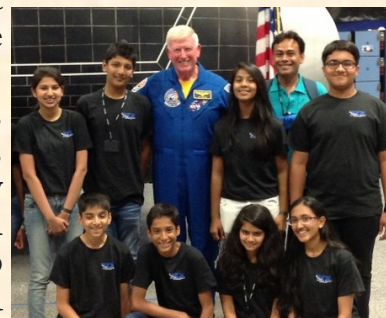
## EXTENDING A HELPING HAND
