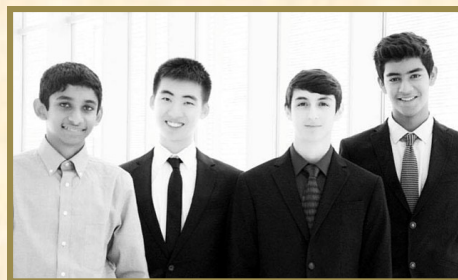


AIR 41

12 Shishyans participated in the Youth Parliament held at The Daly College. They interacted with delegates from schools

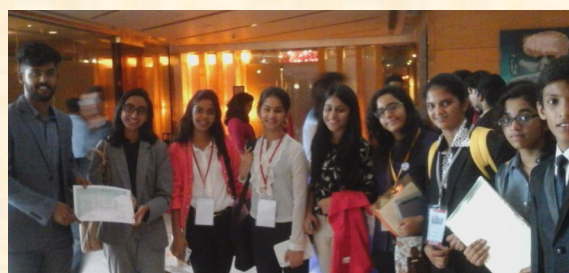


across the country and gained a deeper insight into world issues through discussions and debate.

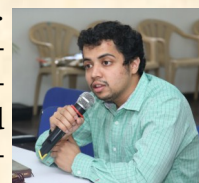
Conclave of International Diplomats

Germany

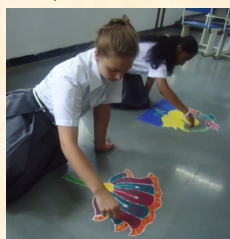

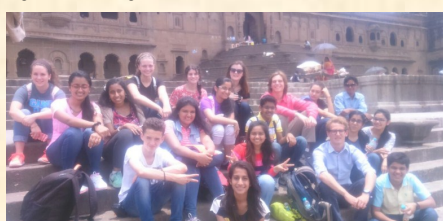
His German host, Felix will be hosted by the school from July – September 2016.
