Shishyans continue to exhibit their creativity by using the big display boards in the OTS as the 'stage' for Inter-House Wall Magazine Competition which is held every month.

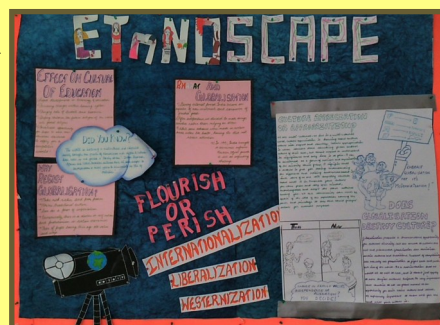

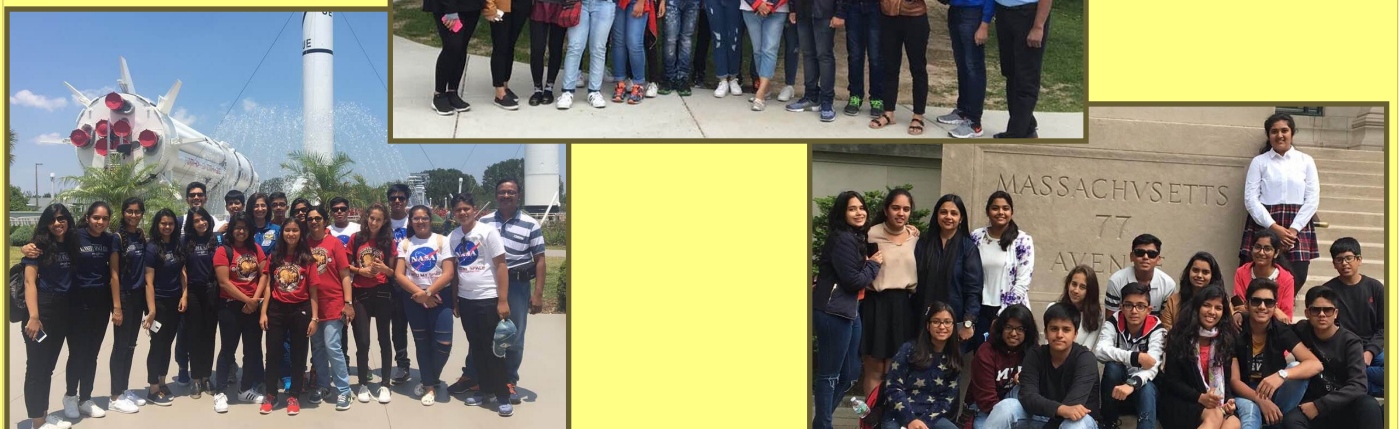

Swimming Advait Brings Glory

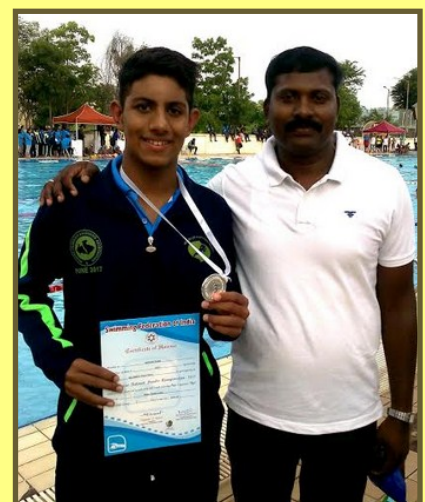
