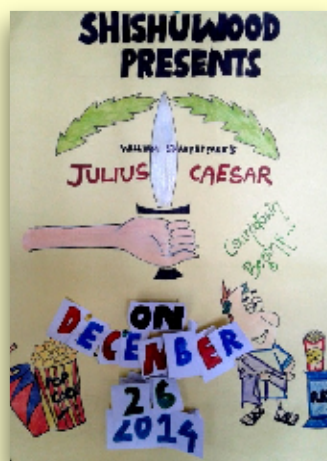
### SO LONG ..... FAREWELL!
