The overall assessment of a student constitutes of both scholastic and co-scholastic areas. The scholastic grading shall be done based on the **8-point grading scale**.

The student will be assessed in co-scholastic areas on the following parameters:

- Work Education (Skill-based activities)
- Art Education (Visual and Performing Arts).
- Health and Physical Education (Sports / Martial Arts, etc).
- Discipline (Attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, turnout, respect for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation, and others).

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The co-scholastic areas shall be graded as per a **3-point grading scale**.

PROMOTION POLICY

1. No overall grading shall be calculated.
2. It is mandatory to score 33% in each subject to be promoted to the next class.

POLICY REGARDING ABSENTEES IN ANY EXAMINATION

1. Appearing in DAs, Half Yearly Examination, and Final Examination is mandatory. No examination will be conducted either before or after the scheduled date and time. A student absent from any examination without any substantial reason will be marked absent for the exam. A minimum of 90% attendance is mandatory to appear for the Final Examination.
2. If a student has not appeared in an examination without any genuine reason and has not submitted her/his leave application, she/he will be marked absent and will be awarded a ZERO.
3. If a student does not appear in any of the examinations because of medical reasons(subject to submission of an application along with relevant medical documents/certificate) or due to representing the school in Inter-School competitions, she/he would be allowed to give that examination on some alternative date/s given by the school.
4. DAs can not be rescheduled as they are conducted through an external agency.
