Detailed Assessment:

- > 8 rounds in English, Math, and Science (4 rounds before Half-Yearly Examination and 4 rounds after Half-Yearly Examination)
- > 2 rounds in Hindi and Social Science (1 round before Half-Yearly Examination and 1 round after Half-Yearly Examination)
- Half Yearly Examination
- Final Examination

It is mandatory to take ALS (Assessment of Listening and Speaking Skills) in English and Hindi.

The overall assessment of a student constitutes both scholastic and co-scholastic areas. The scholastic grading shall be done on the basis of **8 points grading scale**



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The student will be assessed in co-scholastic areas on the following parameters:

- 1. Work Education (Skill-based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community).
- 2. Art Education (Visual and Performing Arts).
- 3. Health and Physical Education (Sports / Martial Arts/Yoga, etc).
- 4. Discipline (Attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, turnout, respect for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation, and others).

The Co scholastic areas shall be graded as per 3 point grading scale

PROMOTION POLICY

• Minimum 33% marks in each subject, in aggregate; as well as in Final Examination is required to be declared 'PASS'.

POLICY REGARDING ABSENTEES IN ANY EXAMINATION

- Appearing in DAs, Half Yearly Examination and Final Examination is mandatory. No examination will be conducted either before or after the scheduled date & time. A student absent for any examination without any substantial reason will be marked absent for that exam. A minimum of 90% attendance is mandatory to appear in the Final Examination.
- 2. If a student has not appeared in an exam without a genuine reason and has not forwarded her/his leave application, she/he will be marked absent and will be awarded ZERO.
- 3. If a student does not appear in an examination because of medical reasons (subject to submission of an application along with relevant medical documents/certificates) or due to representing the school in Inter-School competitions, she/he would be allowed to give that exam on an alternative date/s given by the school.
- 4. DAs can not be rescheduled as they are conducted through an external agency.
