- 1) Parents may purchase course books, notebooks and other material from the market.
- 2) Payment of fees etc. is made through the Bank by challan only.
- 3) If fees is not received on or before the due date, penalty will be charged as per the School rules. Those late in paying the fees for more than 90 days of the due date, the name of the student will be automatically deleted from the rolls. The TC will be issued only after clearance of the dues.
- 4) Imprest Money of Rs. 7000/- will be payable along with the 2nd installment, before July 15, 2023.

An imprest is a cash amount that an institution relies on to pay for small, routine expenses on behalf of students.

Funds contained in imprest are regularly replenished in order to maintain a desired balance. The term imprest refers to a monetary advance given to the institution for defined purposes like competitive exams and activities, local excursion, rent for costumes, price of books bought from the book fate, participation charges in adventure camp etc.

Statement of account for imprest money of your ward can be obtained from the accounts department on request.

Unused imprest amount will be refunded at the time of graduation or withdrawal.
