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POLICY REGARDING ABSENTEES IN ANY EXAMINATION

- 1. Appearing in DAs, Mid Term I, Half Yearly Examination and Pre Board I & II Examination is mandatory. No examination will be conducted either before or after the scheduled date and time. Exam dates are decided in advance. The exam cannot be conducted on any other date/day for parents' personal convenience/ requirement.
- 2. If a student has not appeared in an examination, she/he will be marked absent and will be awarded a ZERO.
- 3. 75% Attendance is a must for a student to appear for Board Examination. The school sends a report of attendance to CBSE in the first week of February and in case a student falls short of the mandatory attendance, then he/she will not be eligible to appear in the Board examination. Please ensure that your ward fulfills attendance criteria.
