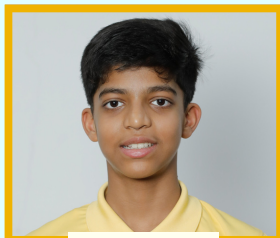


ALUMNI MEET

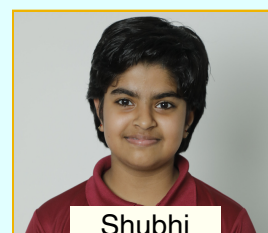
