Evaluation Pattern - Class I

- 1. Assessment in Class I is an ongoing and formative process. The assessment covers the concepts done in class which include numeracy and literacy skills and the understanding of the world around them. The students' participation in activities and class discussions are observed and documented by the educators on a day to day basis.
- 2. At Shishukunj, we believe in giving the children enough time to develop their innate talents as well as academic and non academic skills. The progress of the child is measured against his / her own performance.
- 3. The overall assessment of a student constitutes both scholastic and co-scholastic areas.

The students will be assessed in the following co-scholastic areas:

- Information & Communication Technology (ICT)
- Art & Craft
- Music
- Dance
- Sports

The aptitude and skills of the students in the co-scholastic areas will be evaluated on a continuous basis.

4. The holistic progress cards will be sent twice a year which will include qualitative feedback on the cultivation of the students' personal competencies, skills and attitudes.
