The presentation concluded with a vibrant dance performance showcasing the courage and sacrifices of the Indian Armed Forces.



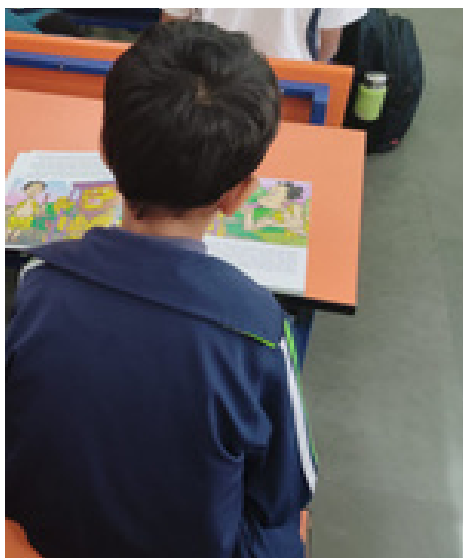
## DARPAN - ASSEMBLY PRESENTATION

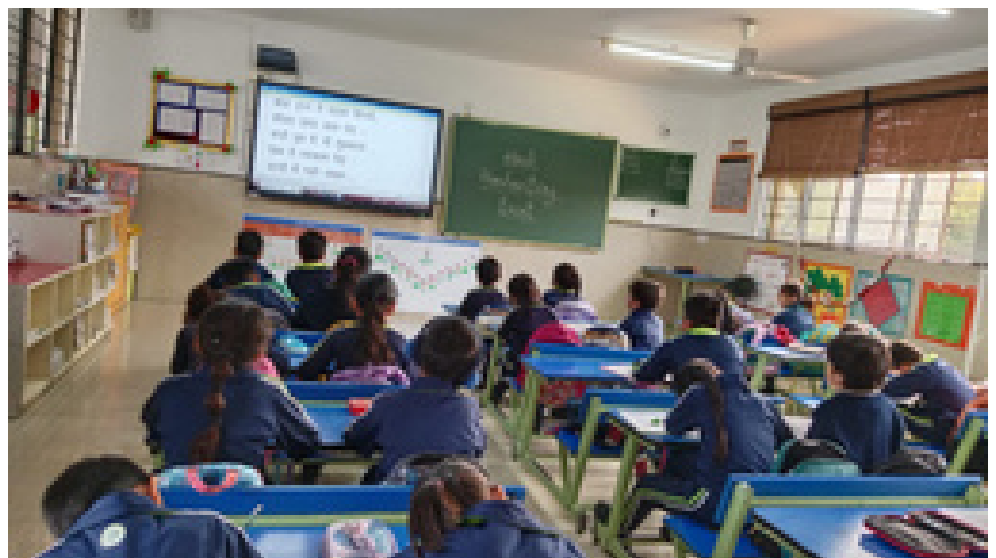
## DRAWING EVENT

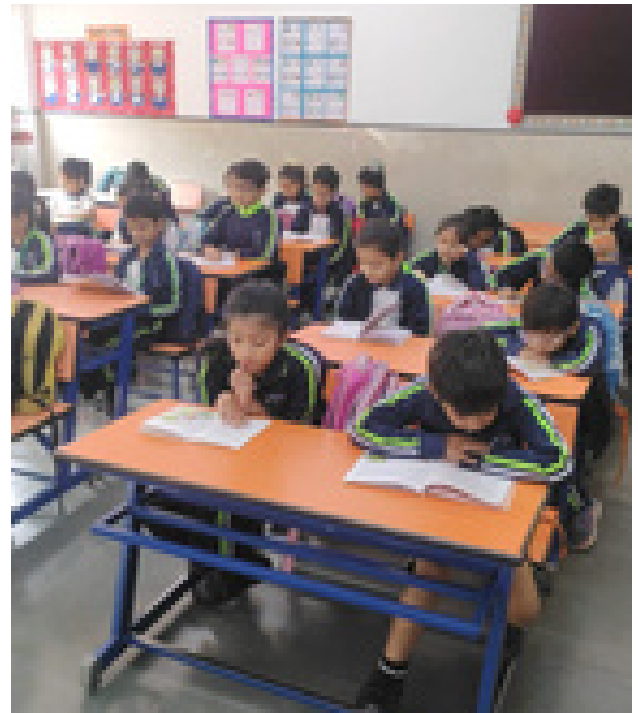
## DARPAN - ASSEMBLY PRESENTATION

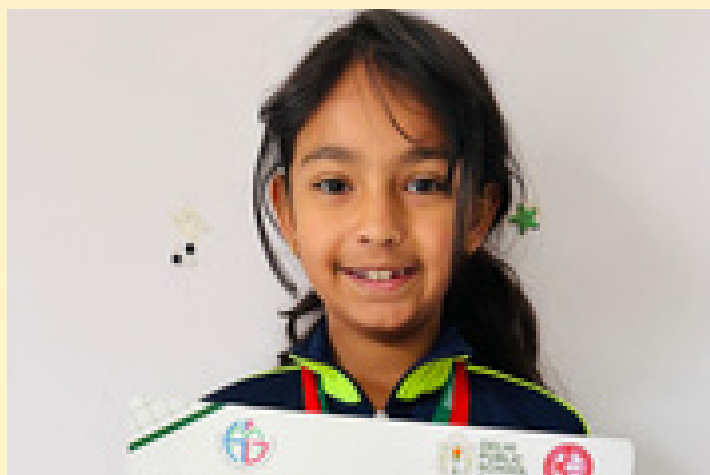
