ORIENTATION ABOUT PUBLIC SPEAKING

The first event of the academic session for the Junior Wing for Classes I to V was conducted on 1st and 2nd April 2026, focusing on the importance of public speaking. During the session, teachers addressed the students and discussed the value of effective communication and how public speaking contributes to building confidence, clarity of thought and self-expression. The session aimed at preparing students for the various public speaking opportunities planned throughout the year.



LISTENING SKILLS EVENT

Our little Shishyans of Sr. KG participated joyfully in the Listening Skills Event conducted for them on 1st April 2026. With bright eyes and eager minds, they listened carefully to the instructions and brought each picture to life with beautiful colours. It was heartwarming to see their focus, enthusiasm, and excitement as they followed directions with care. ENGLISH HANDWRITING (I TO V) & LISTENING SKILLS EVENT (III TO V)

On 8th and 9th April 2026, **Classes I to V** participated in activities aimed at enhancing the Shishyans' language skills.

The first activity was an English handwriting exercise wherein the students of Classes I to V copied the given text neatly. It evaluated the students' proficiency in legibility, presentation and writing fluency.

The second activity focused on listening comprehension, where students of Classes III to V listened to narratives and completed related exercises in their Practice Skill Book to hone their listening skills, vocabulary, attention to detail and retention.

These activities were designed to strengthen core language skills, including listening, comprehension, vocabulary and written expression, while also tracking students' overall progress.



PUBLIC SPEAKING EVENT – MYSELF
