POLICY REGARDING ABSENTEES IN ANY EXAMINATION

- 1. Appearing in DAs, Half Yearly Examination, and Pre Board Examinations are mandatory. No examination will be conducted either before or after the scheduled date and time. A student absent from any examination without any substantial reason will be marked absent for the examinations. A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to appear for the Board Examination.
- 2. If a student has not appeared in an examination without any genuine reason and has not submitted her/his leave application, she/he will be marked absent and will be awarded a ZERO.
- 3. If a student does not appear in any of the examinations because of medical reasons (subject to submission of an application along with relevant medical documents/certificate) or due to representing the school in Inter-School competitions, she/he would be allowed to give the examination on some alternative date/s given by the school.
- 4. DAs can not be rescheduled as they are conducted through an external agency.
