## **Classes VI – VIII: ART GALLERY**

Theme: What Freedom Means to Me

Size: A4

Medium: Any

Students are required to create an art work (A4 size) on the above theme and upload it on google forms latest by 12 August 2020. The google form will be shared with students shortly. Their art work will be displayed virtually through a collage on 15 August 2020.

## **Classes IX – X: Hindi Poem**

Students interested in reciting a poem in Hindi on 15 August 2020 need to audition for the same. They are required to select a poem which will ignite the feeling of patriotism and recite it in front of the selection panel on 11 August 2020 from 3.00 pm. onwards. Students will be added to Audition Room 2 in Google Classroom, the invite will be sent by Saturday evening, kindly accept the invite. Students will be judged on:

- Selection of Poem
- Expression and voice modulation
- Confidence
- Overall Impact

Students giving the audition are required to learn the poem; they will not be permitted to refer to a paper.

Only one student will be selected to recite the poem on 15 August 2020.

## **Classes XI – XII: Speech in English**

Students interested in delivering a speech on 15 August 2020 need to audition for the same. They are required to deliver a speech of about 2 minutes suitable for the occasion in front of the selection panel on 10 August 2020 from 2.00 p.m onwards. Students will be added to Audition Room 1 in Google Classroom, the invite will be sent by Saturday evening, kindly accept the invite.

Students will be judged on:

- Content
- Expression and voice modulation
- Confidence
- Overall impact

Students giving the audition are required to learn the speech; they will not be permitted to refer to a paper.

Only one student will be selected to deliver a speech on 15 August 2020

### **Classes XI – XII: Anchors**

Students interested in anchoring the 15 August programme need to audition for the same. They are required to deliver an introduction of the programme of about 1 minute in front of the selection panel on 10 August 2020 from 3.00 pm onwards. Students will be added to Audition Room 1 in Google Classroom , the invite will be sent by Saturday evening, kindly accept the invite.

Students will be judged on:

- Content
- Expression and voice modulation
- Overall impact

One boy and one girl will be selected to anchor the programme.

Students selected to participate in the Independence Day programme will be required to come to school on 12 August 2020 for the purpose of recording.
