Subject: Qualifying Test for Enrollment in NCC 2020 - 21

Namaste

Hope you and your family are safe and healthy. We are happy to inform you that we are in the process of enrolling **1st year NCC Cadets (Air Force Wing)** for the academic session 2020 - 21.

Shishyans of **Class VIII are eligible for enrollment**. Overall **26 Cadets** are to be enrolled for the 1st year in the session 2020 - 21. The criteria for enrollment will be **the performance in the Qualifying Test and the student's participation in Games and Sports** at Inter-House / Inter-School / District / Division / State / Regional / National / International level.

The weightage will be as given below :

Qualifying Test	50%
Participation in Games and Sports	50%

The **NCC Enrollment Qualifying Test 2020 - 21** will be conducted on **Saturday, October 17, 2020**.

Kindly take a careful note of the following points regarding the same:

1. The qualifying test will be conducted **online through the Google Classroom**.
2. The qualifying test will have **25 one word answer questions**. Students need to write the **answers in the Google Form itself**.
3. The questions will be based on General Knowledge and National Defence.
4. The timing of the qualifying test will be from **10:00 am to 10:45 am**, i.e. total duration of the test will be **45 minutes**.

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) in India is a voluntary organization which enrolls cadets from high schools, colleges and Universities all over India and provides military training. NCC has a multi dimensional impact on the overall development of a student. Few of them are listed below:

1. Personality Development:

- Helps in developing character, comradeship, discipline, a secular outlook, the spirit of adventure and ideals of selfless service amongst young citizens.
- Helps in developing leadership qualities in all walks of life, motivating them to serve the Nation regardless of which career they choose.

- It also provides an environment conducive to motivating young Indians to join the armed forces.
- It develops respect for diversities in religion, language, culture, ethnicity, lifestyle and habitat to instill a sense of National unity and social cohesion.
- It develops the ability to participate in community development and other social programmes.
- Create a healthy lifestyle free of substance abuse and other unhealthy practices.
- Develops sensitivity to the needs of poor and socially disadvantaged fellow citizens.
- Develops respect for knowledge, wisdom and the power of ideas.
- Inculcates habits of restraint and self-awareness.

2. Career Prospect:

- 60 Engineering Seats, 16 Medical Seats, 6-7% of Post Graduation seats are reserved for NCC cadets in all Indian Universities.
- NCC cadets are offered a special quota in case of final selection to join the armed forces.
- NCC Cadets are eligible for SSC without even qualifying for a CDS written exam. All they have to do is clear the SSB interview.
