Subject : Concern Regarding Attendance and Completion of Assignments

Dear Parents
Namaste

This is to bring to your kind attention our growing concern about the attendance of students in the online classes. In spite of our repeated reminders, we find that several students are still not attending the classes regularly, very often they merely switch off their cameras and are not physically present during the class.

The other area of concern is the submission of assignments. Assignments are given regularly in various subjects and are required to be completed within the stipulated time. Once again, we observe that several students have a very casual approach towards these assignments and do not bother to complete them at all or complete them after repeated reminders. **Kindly note, if students do not submit their assignments on time, they will be required to come to school and personally submit the assignment on the date and time decided by the teacher.**

We trust you will appreciate that immense effort is being put into the online classes by the teachers and the management. We have had several instances wherein teachers have taken classes from hospital wards while tending to sick members of their families. As such, we would like students to derive maximum benefit from the online classes. As is well understood, the key to the success of online teaching is self study and a sense of responsibility of the learners.

We seek your kind cooperation in ensuring that your ward attends the classes regularly and also completes the assignments on time. As already informed to you, internal assessment will be a major factor in the final grades of the students and both the above mentioned parameters will be taken into consideration for the same. **Marks will be deducted for non compliance of the above .**

Kindly support the efforts of the school in ensuring that learning continues for all our dear Shishyans, even during these very challenging times.
