### **Subject: Delay in Declaring the Result of First Major Examinations**

This mail is to communicate to you the reason for the delay in declaring the result of the First Major Examination conducted in September – October 2020.

Conducting the examination online has been a real challenge, as well as a learning experience for our entire team. As you are aware, we tried to conduct the examination in the best possible way, given the challenging circumstances. Unlike most of the other schools, which conducted just an Objective Type paper using Google forms, we decided to have both an Objective and Subjective paper, so as to have a 360 degree assessment of the student's learning. The educators, as always, put in great efforts to make the question papers as per the new format, and the mock test conducted about 10 days prior to the examination, gave students adequate practice to attempt the paper and upload the answer scripts.

We are happy to share that the examination was conducted smoothly and we are indeed grateful to the parents for their cooperation and support for the same. However, in spite of our best efforts, we faced a problem in accessing the answer scripts. A few students were unable to upload the answer scripts, a few answer scripts were not scanned properly making it impossible for the educators to read the text and a few answer scripts were sent to the incorrect email id. This led to an inordinate delay in completing the corrections, which we are happy to say are now complete. Our tech team is working round the clock to compile the marks, but as you may understand, it is taking more time than we had anticipated.

This mail is to request you to kindly bear with us for the delay in declaring the result of the First Major Examination. We would like to assure you that we may have fallen short of declaring the result within the stipulated time, but we are definitely not lacking in our efforts to hasten the process.

We have already begun formulating a new strategy for conducting the next set of examinations and will keep you posted of the same. For everything we do, we try to ensure that the learning of our dear Shishyans is not compromised at any level. It is not for us to walk the beaten path, which you will understand, at times, poses unexpected challenges.
