It's time for an event which offers our Shishyans a host of activities to choose from and showcase their talent. **Kaleidoscope** will be conducted for our junior Shishyans **from Monday, 22nd March to Friday, 27th March.**

The Shishyans can select **any one** activity from the list of activities mentioned as under:

- 1. Public Speaking** - The participants will speak about :
 - a quote that they like the most and why (Time limit - 2 minutes)**OR**
 - a character from a story which truly inspires them (Time limit - 2 minutes)
- 2. Ikebana** - Ikebana is the Japanese art of flower decoration. The participants of this event will arrange flowers of their choice in an artistic manner.
- 3. Best Out of Waste** - The participants will create something useful out of material which is no longer needed at home.
- 4. Folk Song** - The Shishyans who opt for this event will sing a folk song. They are free to use a musical instrument of their choice while presenting their song. (Time limit - 2 minutes)
- 5. Folk Dance** - The young dancers participating in this event will perform a folk dance of their choice. They are free to wear the required costume and accessories to enhance their performance. (Time limit - 2 minutes)

For the music and dance activities, please ensure that a folk song / a folk dance is chosen and not songs / dances from movies, otherwise it will lead to disqualification.



Kindly note that your child will have to enter his / her choice in a **Google Form** which will be shared on the Stream Section of the Google Classroom **on Wednesday, 10th March 2021**. The **last date** of submitting the form is **Friday, 12th March 2021**.
