# ACADEMICS | School Copy

The school copy is meant for taking down the important points/notes during a period and for doing all the class work.

- At any given time, there will be two school copies- one exclusively for Mathematics and the second for the rest of the subjects.
- School copies are to be numbered 1,2,3,....., as many such copies will be used during the year.
- Students must preserve all school copies carefully and refer to them from time to time for the purpose of revision.



# ACADEMICS | Master Copy

- This will be the 'fair' copy. Students will be given various exercises for enhancing their understanding of various topics taught in class. These exercises will have to be done in the Master copy.
- Students are required to maintain a separate Master Copy for each subject
- All assignments (Home Assignments as well as Class assignments) are to be done in the Master Copy



# ACADEMICS | Home Assignments

- Home Assignments will be given at regular intervals.
- The purpose is to enable the students to review what has been taught in class and also practice the same at home.
- As such, the homework assigned is always given in small portions and sufficient time is given to complete it.



# ACADEMICS | Syllabus

- The Syllabus Progression Plan for the entire session is uploaded on the school website.





# CO CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
