
In light of the challenges faced by the pandemic, SHISMUN has yet again crafted a compelling experience online, living up to our revered legacy.

Awards

Best Delegate, High Commendation(s), Special Mention(s) in each committee will receive merit certificates within 5 working days of the conference. The Best Delegate in each committee is entitled to a monetary prize of INR 2500. Best Journalist will receive a monetary prize of INR 2500. Best Caricaturist will receive a monetary prize of INR 2500. The Best School Delegation Award is given to the institution whose students have excelled in the Conference, demonstrating skills appropriate to their roles as representatives of nations and portfolios. This performance is approved by the Executive Board(s) of respective committees and is solely based on their discretion.

A Delegation will be established as a team of duly registered participants from one institution, representing one or more countries/portfolios in a minimum of five out of any of the eight committees being simulated at the Scottish High International Model United Nations 2021. This presence is irrespective of the number of Delegates the Delegation has in that committee, provided there is a minimum of one delegate per committee in any of those 5 or more chosen committees. Each Delegation fulfilling these criteria shall be given ONE point. Moreover, Each Delegation has the opportunity to obtain the following points for each award their delegates receive in their respective committees:

Best Delegate Award: FIVE POINTS

High Commendation Award: THREE POINTS

Special Mention Award: ONE POINT

The Delegation with the highest points shall be awarded the Best School Delegation Award.
